

## English

First Half Term: Writing conducted with a focus on the Narrative 'Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo. We will look at: character descriptions, diary entries, information texts and traditional story set in Ancient Egypt.

For the second half term our writing will focus on the core text Alice in Wonderland by Emma Chichister Clark (based on the original story by Lewis Carroll). Children will explore settings and characters, learn how to summarise the text and role play conversations which will lead them into writing and punctuating direct speech. There will also be lots of opportunities for guided reading.

## Maths

Number: Decimals This will include tenths, hundredths, comparing, ordering and rounding. This will also include money.

Measurement: Time Children will learn about months, years, hours, minutes and seconds.

Statistics Children will learn to interpret pictograms, tables and bar charts.

Geometry: Properties of Shape We will study, compare and draw angles. Children will learn about 2D and 3D shapes.

Geometry: Position and Direction Children will learn about symmetric figures and describe position.

Measurement: Money This will include counting in pounds and pence, adding and subtracting money.

## History

We will be learning about the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians.

Tombs and mummification.

We will be completing our topic of animals including humans as well as having our trips to Oldham Regional Science Centre.
